The Coconino County Farm Bureau & Cattle Growers' Scholarship provides financial assistance to undergraduate college students enrolled in a university or community college.

Application deadline:

Postmarked on or before **August 31** of the fall semester and
January 31 of the spring semester.

To be eligible, a student must:

1. Be enrolled or accepted as a full time (12 credit hours) undergraduate student.
2. Have a minimum 2.5 GPA to apply.
3. Applicant must be a dependant of a Coconino County Farm Bureau Agriculture member.

Required Documents for Application:

1. This completed application.
2. Two letters of recommendation from persons other than family members.
3. Official transcripts from high school or college where currently attending.
4. Letter of intent: include your high school and/or college achievements, awards, honors, extra-curricular activities, college you are planning to attend, major, and plans upon graduation. This should not exceed one double-spaced 8 ½" X 11" single-sided paper, using a 12 point font.
5. Answer the following question in 750 words or less:

"Radical environmentalism has proven to be one of the largest challenges and impediments to modern agriculture. How will you use your education to answer this challenge?"
