## WITH ARIZONA AGRICULTURE WHEAT

- 🊏 Wheat is grown in 42 states!
- Tone acre of wheat produces about 40 bushels of wheat.
- 🊏 One bushel of wheat weighs about 60 pounds.
- Tone bushel of wheats can yield about 90 one-pound loaves of whole wheat bread!
- The phrase "Desert Durum®" has been trademarked with the U.S. Patent Office under the ownership of the Arizona Grain Research and Promotion Council.
- One bushel of wheat makes about forty-five 24-ounce boxes of cereal.
- Arizona Desert Durum® wheat is planted November through February and harvested in May and June.
- Most of the exported Desert Durum® is exported to Italy to make pasta.
- Thesert Durum® grow best in high temperatures with low rainfall.
- Desert Durum® enters the market up to three months earlier than wheat harvested in Northern states.
- One bushel of wheat makes 42 pounds of pasta or about 210 servings of spaghetti! In order to eat that much pasta, you would have to eat pasta three times a week for 70 weeks!
