GOATS



Goats can be raised for milk or meat.



Goat meat is the most consumed meat per capita worldwide.



The meat from a goat is called chevon. Although many people call it mutton which can also be used for sheep meat.



A male goat is called a buck or billie, a female goat is called a doe or nannie, and baby goats are called kids.



Goats can run 15 miles an hour.



Goats are pregnant for 5 months. An average they have 2 kids per year.



Goats have four compartment stomachs. They are foragers, not grazers. They prefer to reach up high to forage.



A goat's pupil is rectangular and not round. This gives them vision for 320 to 340 degrees around without moving. They also have good night vision.
