Thank you for your interest in the 2021 Arizona Century Farm recognition program, sponsored by the Arizona Farm Bureau.

Please fill out the following application completely; incomplete applications will not be considered. All the qualifications must be met at the time the application is submitted.

The annual application deadline is the first Monday in July (July 5, 2021) and must be received by Arizona Farm Bureau by that date (this is not a postmark deadline). Qualified applications received after July 5 will be considered for the 2022 Century Farm and Ranch.

Qualifications for inclusion are as follows:

1. The farm or ranch must be at least 100 years old by the end of 2021 according to abstract of title, land patent, original deed, county land records, court file in registration proceedings or other authentic land records.
 - a. The applicant should verify that the farm qualifies as a Century Farm, but we do not require direct proof.
 - b. Please do not send supporting documentation, only the completed application.
2. Farm or ranch is family-owned for 100 years or more. (Present owner must be related to the original owner)
 - a. "Family" defined as i. parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, sons, daughters, first cousins and direct in-laws (father, mother, brother, sister, daughter, son-in-law).
3. Family ownership must be continuous.
4. Continuous residence on farm is not required.
5. Farm or ranch must be currently involved in agricultural production.
6. A farm or ranch may be recognized only once.

7. Applicant must be a member of Arizona Farm Bureau.

Qualifying farms or ranch will receive

1. One personalized certificate of recognition, signed by the Governor of Arizona, and the President of Arizona Farm Bureau.

2. One metal sign, ***proclaiming the farm or ranch is a "Century Farm."*** Arizona Century Farm and Ranch Recognition Program ceremonies are handled by the County Farm Bureau where this milestone may be celebrated with friends, family and neighbors. Certificates and signs will be sent to the respective County Farm Bureau leadership.

Only one sign and certificate will be awarded per farm. Arizona Farm Bureau will also conduct a recognition ceremony during its Annual Meeting. The Century Farm status is only conferred on a farm or ranch one time.

The Arizona Farm Bureau thanks you for your interest in the Century Farm and Ranch program. The Arizona Farm Bureau honors Arizona families who have owned their farms and ranches for at least 100 years, are at least 50 acres in size and are currently involved in agricultural production.
